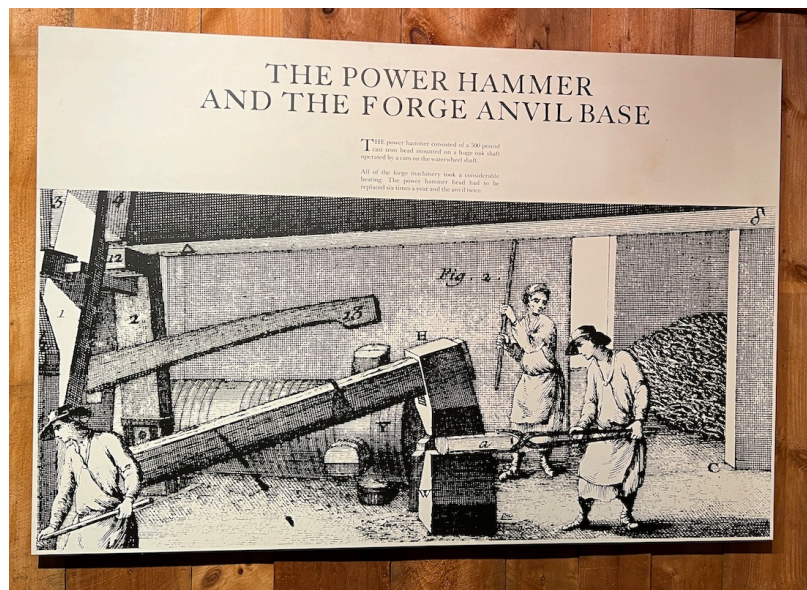

See the water-driven giant power hammer, forges with water-powered bellows and other work sites. We will enjoy a catered lunch on the beautiful grounds overlooking the river.
